Welcome to the NFB Awards 2019



Categories:

Site of the Year

Nominate a site that sets the standards in terms of delivery, efficiency and team work and runs like a well-oiled machine to live up to client expectations. In fact, it ran so smoothly that you could be forgiven for forgetting about it because the project was so stress free and seamless! Tell us who was involved, what they built and how they achieved status as your site of the year - a shining example of all that you could hope for and an outstanding example of construction at it's best.

Collaboration of the Year

This award recognises a commitment to partnering and working to demonstrate benefits of collaboration in projects, enhanced by reference to aligned values, sharing best practice and risks, working together as one and achieving shared goals which lead to tangible outcomes. Examples of benefits derived from the collaborative working should be used to illustrate the effectiveness of the relationships and enhanced operations throughout the supply chain.

Innovation in Project Delivery

Innovation includes new techniques used in the design, build or management of a project. Entries can be based on technological advances, construction methods or materials. If you tried something new and it worked out well, we want to know about it. What did you do and how did you go about it?

Training Programme of the Year*

Recognising excellence in all aspects of training, such as employee development, craft apprenticeships, community driven initiatives, work experience and liaison with education establishments. Show us what makes your training programme excellent and how are you demonstrating the results?

New Build Project of the Year

Awarded for a project that demonstrates innovation, design impact, and value for money. This award is open for any type of building and we are looking for exceptional achievement throughout the project as well as in the finished result. This could include examples of best practice in project management, collaborative working, a visually pioneering design, or high levels of user satisfaction and comfort.

Heritage Project of the Year

Awarded for conscientious work carried out to improve a heritage building or estate. Examples of collaborative working, ambitious makeovers in keeping with the challenges to maintain tradition, or evidence of the adoption of new trends and working methods to create originality, or initiatives to keep alive the skills and specialist knowledge required for restorative work will bring success in this category.

Refurbishment Project of the Year

Awarded for innovation and creativity in improving a building or estate. The winner will be able to demonstrate examples of collaborative working, ambitious makeovers, evidence of the adoption of new trends and working methods to create originality, or economic savings through new ways of working.

Housebuilder of the Year Award

Awarded for a project that demonstrates design impact, enhancement of the community, value for money, exceptional maintenance and asset management programmes, energy efficiency or other such benefit to the community and to business. This could include examples of best practice in project management, collaborative working, a visually pioneering design, or high levels of user satisfaction and comfort.

* Entry is open to NFB members and non-members working to upskill the construction industry in England and Wales



What the judges are looking for

Objective setting and achievement

Entries should demonstrate where applicable a clear, well-formed and communicated strategy which aides the achievement of the project objective.

Tactical implementation

Entries should demonstrate a methodical approach to implementation, with special emphasis on measurement and control and feedback on projects from clients.

Creativity

Creativity however small will be appreciated within any entry.

Effectiveness

Winners must be able to demonstrate the value the project has to their clients. Particular emphasis will be placed by judges on whether the project was completed to schedule and to budget. Any problems must be justified and an explanation given as to how they were overcome.

Entry rules

- Members banded A-C (turnover under £1,500,000) are welcome to enter all categories free of charge
- All categories for entry by members banded D and above (turnover over £1,500,001), and non-members, are £30 + VAT per entry
- Construction Employer of the Year category is free to enter regardless of banding / turnover
- Cheques should be made payable to: National Federation of Builders and sent to the Gatwick address or paid via BACS – sort code: 40-04-25 Account number: 31384422. Please quote 'Awards 2019' followed by your NFB membership number or company name as your payment reference
- Entries will be accepted up until Friday 15 February 2019
- Text should be limited to a total of 1000 words, we advise 250 words per question. Those exceeding these limits will have marks deducted
- Projects must have been completed between January 2017 – December 2018
- Companies may enter as many categories as they wish. However each entry must be accompanied by a separate entry pack
- Entrants must ensure there are no copyright issues with any submissions
- Entry assumes agreement for the federation / media to reproduce any element of the award entry free from any reproduction fees
- The judging panels' decision is final and no discussion or correspondence relating to any decisions will be entered into.

Criteria

- Each entry should be limited to no more than 1000 words
- Images (where available) should be submitted to support the entry and a maximum of 5 images will be accepted. Images should be of a high quality, one to be the company logo
- Entries packs should be submitted to awards@builders.org.uk
- Companies entering more than one category should send separate emails per category.
